WHO WE ARE

The International C4I Integration Program Office (PMW 740) is the PEO C4I focal point for security cooperation efforts. Under the authority of U.S. Title 22 (Foreign Military Sales and Foreign Military Financing) cases, and U.S. Title 10 (Building Partner Capacity) cases, we acquire, integrate, test, deliver, and sustain tailored C4I solutions and services to foreign partners in support of US National Security and foreign policy objectives.

PRIORITIES

Strengthen Partnerships

We establish enduring relationships with allied and coalition partners in support of the National Defense Strategy, the CNO's Navigation Plan and the U.S. Tri-Service Maritime Strategy. We engage with Geographic Combatant Commanders (GCC) to identify and refine solutions aligned to their priorities to strengthen international partner capacity to deter, fight and win.

Deliver Capability

We deliver and integrate PEO C4I programs of record and commercial-off-the-shelf products to provide C4I capabilities, tailored to indigenous environments, enabling our foreign partners to operate in joint and combined forces. This includes assistance in building and enhancing partner nations' cybersecurity defense capabilities to support secure and reliable cyberspace operations.

Enhance Interoperability

The capabilities we provide enable partner nations to operate with U.S. forces and independently, without the presence or assistance of the U.S. military, to execute their national and regional self-defense, humanitarian assistance, disaster relief, and other regional security operations.
